WHAT IS FinderExcel?

- ☐ FinderExcel is a simple user-interface that manages your production data and can replace Finder for those Apple volumes that are under your Archive File System's control (Ex: StorNext Storage Manager).
- ☐ The FinderExcel back-end service runs on Linux, and simply needs access to source volumes via NFS, CIFS/SMB, or via the respective Archive File System (Ex: StorNext).
- ☐ The FinderExcel client interface runs on Windows, Linux, or OS-X.

WHY CHOOSE FinderExcel?

FinderExcel not only helps manage your data, but also eliminates the 'Storm' behavior that can occur when an Apple volume is in conflict with an Archive File System, avoiding file retrieves from tape to disk from being triggered, when simply double clicking into an Xsan folder.
